Our number one priority is the health, safety, and wellness of our community. Our ability to mitigate risk relies on **everyone**. Because our collective actions can affect the health and safety of others, it is important to us that when we reopen, all community members onsite and their families by extension feel confident that the school has done everything in our power to protect them. To that end, **we are requiring all staff**, **faculty, and parents who opt for in-person learning** to read, review, and sign the PCS Community Contract and Code of Conduct prior to our campus return.

Please continue to practice the following safety guidelines at home prior to returning to PCS:

- Wear masks in all public spaces and around anyone outside of your immediate household. For CDC guidance on masks, click here.
- Continue to practice physical distancing (6 feet or greater) from anyone outside of your immediate household.
- Continue to practice frequent hand washing. For CDC guidelines with visuals outlining the process of effective hand washing, click here.
- Stay informed. Stay current on LA County guidelines and stay-at-home orders.
- Avoid non-essential travel and gatherings. If you must travel, please closely monitor conditions of
 destinations and practice safety measures such as physical distancing, wearing masks, and
 enhanced hygienic practices. Please report recent travel to the school for instructions on when it is
 safe for your child to return to school.
- Keep us informed. Make sure all emergency contact information is up to date on FACTS.
