Subject: Campus Expansion Update from Judith & Jenn - March 12, 2021

Dear PCS Parents,

We wanted to keep you updated on what lies ahead as we prepare to expand our on-campus learning program. Like many of you, we've recently learned that LA County is poised to reach the less restrictive Red Tier, as outlined by the California Department of Public Health's [Blueprint for a Safer Economy](#), on Monday, March 15. All schools must document their re-opening protocols for additional grades (7th and 8th) 5 days prior to their start date. We will submit our required documentation on Monday, 3/15 once they officially announce the switch to the Red Tier.

What does that mean for Park Century?

7th and 8th grade students participating in in-person learning will be able to come to school four days a week starting Monday, March 22. Like our Lower School students, 7th and 8th grade students will come in for half days on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. Please see below for a revised schedule (7th & 8th grade in red).
